

# IMPORTANT INFORMATION: EVERGREEN SESSIONS FOR INDIVIDUAL CAMPERS



## Check-In Time

Check in is from 4:00 - 5:30 pm on the first day of camp. Upon arrival to camp, our camp staff will greet you and deliver your camper's luggage to the cabin area. You will then go to the check-in area to pick up your camper's cabin assignment and drop off any medications with the nurse. You and your camper may then tour the grounds, cool down with a delicious smoothie from Cedar Creek Coffee Shop, and meet your camper's counselor. Parents are invited to a parent's meeting at 5:45 pm in the Lodge, followed by a complimentary BBQ.

## Check-Out Day and Time

Please meet your child at the Forum at 10:00 am on the last day of camp.

Note: Check-out days vary depending on session - please read your confirmation letter to verify your check-out day.

If you ordered when you registered, you do not need to do anything further at check-in, just be sure to pick them up the last day of camp.

## Health and Safety of Campers

The health and safety of each camper is our top priority. Our qualified medical personnel will care for any illness or injury sustained while at camp. A quality 24-hour medical facility is located in nearby Lebanon should their services be needed. Our medical personnel collect and distribute all medicines to campers. Remember... all prescription medications MUST be in original container with camper's name, name of medication, and directions clearly marked on the pharmacy label. All over-the-counter medications MUST be in the original container and accompanied by parental instructions. Medications not complying with this policy will NOT be given.

## Lost and Found Policy

Please label all belongings. Camp Tadmor is not responsible for lost items. Please keep track of all items sent to camp. It is your responsibility to call and make arrangements to look for and pick up lost items. All lost and found items will be kept for two weeks after each camp session. Any lost and found items left longer than two weeks will be taken to a local charity.

# PACKING CHECKLIST FOR CAMP



## What to Bring to Camp:

- Pack all items in closeable luggage (not a pil-lowcase or open handbag)
- T-shirts (modest)
- Shorts (modest, at least 3.5" inseam)
- Jeans/long pants
- Underwear
- Socks
- Pajamas
- Swimsuits (modest, one piece)
- Shorts that can be worn over swimsuits (girls)
- Set of clothes that you can throw away
- Tennis Shoes
- Sandals (for lake)
- Water shoes (optional)
- Rain gear (check the weather)
- Warm coat
- Theme night attire/costumes (recommended, but not required)
- Laundry bag
- Sleeping Bag
- Pillow
- Water bottle
- Large plastic trash bag (for wet items on last day)
- Toiletries (shampoo, soap, toothbrush/toothpaste)
- Towels
- Sunscreen
- Flashlight
- Bible
- Pencils/pens
- Stationary, stamps, envelopes
- Insect repellent
- \$35-\$100 (for hat, crafts, paintball, snack bar, and other camp store purchases)
- Camera (not on a phone, iPod, or iPad)

## Do Not Bring:

- Cell Phone (We are a cell phone-free camp. Our counselors don't have theirs either)
- Music devices
- Web-based devices (iPads, etc)
- Alcohol/Tobacco/Illegal Drugs/Marijuana
- Weapons (guns, knives, etc.)
- Gum
- Fireworks
- Clothing supporting beer/alcohol companies
- Spaghetti straps
- Tight tank tops
- Crop tops
- Two-piece swimsuits (girls)

Bring that camo to sneak through the woods in stealth mode.



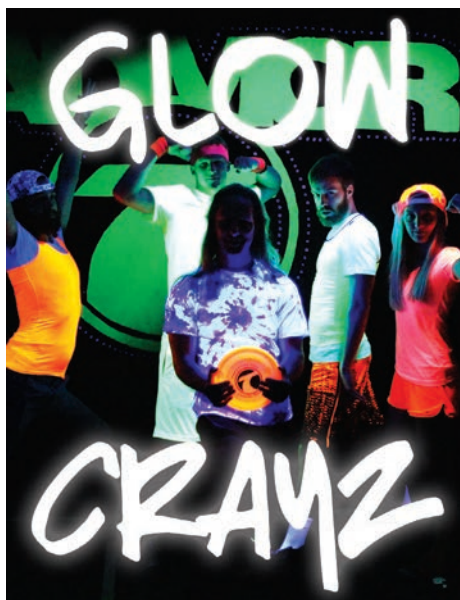
## Luau

Get down Hawaiian style with some grass skirts and tacky shirts. (no coconut bras)



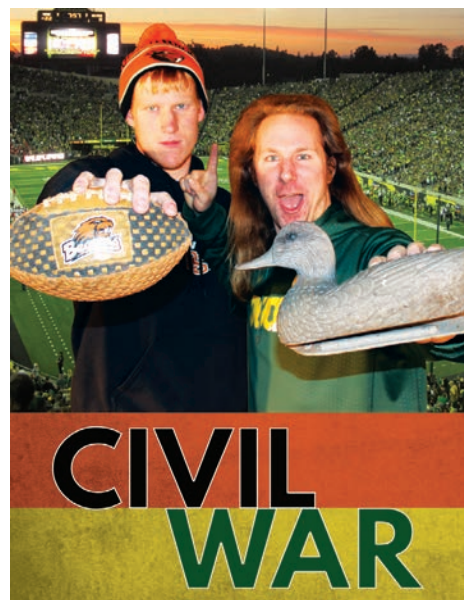
## Paint War
